Semper (A) (2017)

Semper (=always) is a Latin word denoting the continuity of a unity (a certain kind of permanence): etymologically, the word is the composition of the roots **sem* (one, as one, the same, together with [itself]) and **per* (for, during). Semper means then an assembling that is once for all in the conditions of its presentation.

Semper (A) is the first element of a series of acousmatic pieces on this theme.
